Union Township School District Bond Referendum
Special Election January 24, 2023



On Tuesday, January 24th, 2023 the Union Township School District will ask the community to vote on a bond referendum. As parents your students will benefit from the projects proposed in the referendum.

PROJECTS:

The \$2,750,000.00 referendum will fund necessary facility upgrades and renovations at the Middle School. The projects focus on Health, Safety, and Energy Efficiency.

- Exterior Door Replacement - Replace all doors for security and efficiency.
- Interior Door Replacement - Replace all doors for security and efficiency.
- Electrical Upgrade and HVAC Improvements – Upgrade our electrical service, upgrade the HVAC system to include renovations and replace “end of life equipment”, air conditioning throughout the building and the gymnasium. The new high efficiency equipment will provide fresh air ventilation, improved air filtration, and cooling for classrooms.

FUNDING:

If the referendum is approved, the District is **eligible to receive up to 40% in state aid** to cover project costs (state aid is only available if referendum passes). Funds exist in the district’s capital reserve account to cover up to \$1 million of the project and the remainder to the taxpayer.

SAVE THE DATE:

On Thursday, December 8th, 2022 we will be holding a public presentation about its upcoming referendum at 12:00 noon and 7:45 pm in the Middle School Library, 165 Perryville Road, Hampton, NJ 08827. All voters are welcome to attend.
